- + *In theoretical perspective*: The thesis outlined the theoretical issues related to internal control and internal control system in the enterprise as follow:
- To systematize and supplement the basic argument about the internal control system in the enterprise.
- Clarify the concepts, roles and components of the internal control system in the enterprise
- Clarify the nature and characteristics of the internal control system in the holding company subsidiary enterprise.
- To propose a model which can measure the effectiveness of the enterprise's internal control system, based on the study of David Brewer and William List (2014).

## + New recommendations from research results:

The thesis proposed some recommendations on enhancing the internal control system in Vietnam Post as follows:

- + Enhancing the control environment, including: Raise the awareness of the administrators in the holding company and subsidiaries of Vietnam Post; Enhancing the organizational structure; Enhancing employee policy; Enhancing operational planning in accordance with the requirements of internal control system.
  - + Enhancing the information and communication systems, including: Improving the

information and communication system in the holding company and subsidiaries of Vietnam Post; Improving the accounting information system in the subsidiaries of Vietnam Post.

+ Enhancing control procedures, including: Improve and follow the principles in designing and operating control procedures; enhancing control procedures of basic operations in subsidiaries of Vietnam Post; Implement the model to measure the effectiveness of Vietnam Post's internal control system.

Finally, the thesis has recommended the conditions to implement the solutions proposed.
